LIFE TIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The Life Time Achievement Award recognizes an individual who has given distinguished long-term service to the plant breeding field in such areas as research, education, outreach and leadership.

Deadline for submission: March 15, 2011, 5pm (Pacific Time)

Nomination Package (PDF format):

1. Nomination Letter (minimal requirements; 2-page limit)

- Synopsis of nominee's merits
- Relationship of nominator to nominee (e.g., member of department, chair of department, professional colleague...)
- Succinct statement about experience and perspective of the nominator especially as related to the field of plant breeding
- Contact information of nominator and nominee

2. Curriculum Vitae (minimal requirements)

- I. Name, title, employer, work address.
- II. Professional preparation - listed in reverse chronological order: Degrees, Institutions, and Dates.
- III. Professional history - chronological listing of job titles, employers, places, and dates.
- IV. Grants, Awards and Honors - List awards, research grants, teaching, sabbaticals, invited presentations, and invited lectures received in recognition of research achievements.
- V. PUBLICATIONS - Numbered and in reverse chronological order, within each of the following subcategories,
 - A. Refereed research articles
 - B. Books, chapters, reviews, and monographs
 - C. Non-refereed publications
 - D. Abstracts (published)
 - E. Patents and PVPs
 - F. Cultivar releases
 - G. Germplasm releases

3. Letters of Support

It is suggested that each nomination be accompanied by 2-5 supporting signed letters submitted as PDF files, 1-2 pages each. Each letter should include the respective author's institutional email address and telephone number.

POST-NOMINATION EXPECTATIONS:

1. After being informed of the award, the nominator or awardee should submit the following. These items will be used at the annual meeting, for press releases and announcements.

- a. **Professional sketch:** 200 - 300 words about the award, institutional affiliation and nature of the previous and ongoing research (suitable for use in announcements).
- b. **Digital image(s) of Awardee:** One to several non-copyrighted high-resolution digital images of the nominee in a common image format (non-proprietary), e.g., jpg, tiff, png. Suggestions for inclusion: [a] professional posed image, and [b] showing the awardee at work as a plant breeder.
