Selected students will have the opportunity to:

1. Attend ASTA's Leadership Summit (with financial assistance). This conference will be held in Washington, D.C. June 8-11, 2025 and is one of the most important seed industry meetings in the world, attended by many seed industry professionals from all over the globe. You will have the opportunity to participate in discussions and decision-making forums on some of the most important issues effecting U.S. and world seed trade.
2. Each selected student will be matched with a seed company representative who will act as a mentor during the conference and a resource after the conference.
3. Students will have an opportunity to network with seed industry leaders throughout the conference.
4. Students will have the opportunity to meet with Congress during ASTA's Advocacy Day, with support from ASTA and their paired mentor.
5. ASTA student membership will be granted to students who are a part of *Student Connections*. Benefits of student membership include access to seed industry news, job and internship notifications, complimentary conference registration, and more.
