#### OPENING SESSION & RECEPTION

Join us to kick off the meeting on Sunday, June 14th at 5:30 PM for our Opening Session in Century I & II at the Texas A&M Hotel and Conference Center, followed by a reception at the Block T Bar and Grill. We look forward to seeing you there to start the week together!

#### CONFERENCE LOCATION & CHECK-IN

The 2026 NAPB Annual Meeting will be hosted at the Texas A&M Hotel and Conference Center. Conference check-in will be located on the 2nd floor outside the elevators. Check-in times are posted in our annual meeting booklet.

#### PARKING

The most convenient parking is the Gene Stallings Blvd. Garage (500 Gene Stallings Blvd, College Station, TX 77843), which is directly connected to the Texas A&M Hotel and Conference Center.

#### SHUTTLE SERVICE

For guests staying at The George or Cavalry Court, complimentary shuttles will be running every morning and evening to transport you to and from the conference center. Look for posted signage at your hotel with shuttle times.

#### WHAT TO WEAR & BRING

June in Texas means warm, sunny, and humid conditions — but Texas weather can also be unpredictable! We encourage all attendees, especially those joining tours or outdoor activities, to come prepared:

- Field-ready clothing (light, breathable fabrics recommended)
- Hat or cap for sun protection
- Reusable water bottle (stay hydrated!)
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Rain gear — there is a chance of rain in the forecast, so a travel umbrella or light rain jacket is a smart addition to your bag.

#### TOUR PARTICIPANTS – PLEASE NOTE

If you plan to participate in any field tours during the meeting, please be aware of the following dress code requirements:

- **CLOSED-TOE SHOES ARE REQUIRED**
- **PANTS ARE REQUIRED** (no shorts, skirts, or open-leg clothing)

As there is a chance of rain in the forecast, we also recommend bringing rain- or wet-appropriate closed-toe shoes in case of muddy or wet field conditions.

Open-toe shoes, sandals, and shorts will not be permitted on tour sites.

Please note that our NAPB hotel blocks have closed. If you still need to secure lodging, we encourage you to contact The George or Cavalry Court directly and mention that you are with NAPB — they may still have availability.
